*****Medicine Collection Day for Households** – Bring: Prescription medications, Over the counter medications, Ointments, Sprays, Inhalers, Creams, Vials and Pet medications. No illegal drugs, No Bio-hazardous Materials, No Needles/Sharps, No Personal Care Products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc.)
