



## **Caledonia Park Locations, Amenities and Regulations**

### **Chapla Park**

An 8.9 acre park located along Lake Michigan on Lakeshore Drive in the Crestview Subdivision (7200 block of Lakeshore Drive). This unique park is within walking distance of Racine County's Cliffside Park.

### **Crawford Park**

This 17.9 acre park opened to the public in August of 2002 and achieved the 2003 Park Design Award of Merit from the Wisconsin Park and Recreation Association Park Section. It is located behind the Greentree Mall at 5051 Chester Lane. This park contains 2 ball diamonds, a neighborhood playground, a shelter with electricity running water, flushing toilets (available for rent), walking trails, 2 tennis courts, 2 half court basketball courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, a parking lot, and open space.

### **East Side Community Center** (Caledonia Community Center)

This facility is located at 6156 Douglas Avenue (Highway 32) and is used primarily for Village and other governmental meetings.

### **Gorney Park**

This 40 acre park is located on Nicholson Road just north of 7 Mile Road (8201 Nicholson Road). It has 2 ball diamonds, 2 playgrounds, 2 shelters with electricity, 2 soccer fields (1 full size, 1 practice field), walking trails, and a handicapped accessible fishing pier on a beautiful, fish-stocked pond which will make you want to come back for more fun.

### **Linwood Park**

This 17.8 acre park is located on the Root River off of 5 Mile Road, east of Highway 38 (7305 – 5 Mile Road). It has a shelter (available for rent), a playground, benches, and access directly to the Root River. The Caledonia Historical Society has located the Old Town Hall and the Old Sturtevant Train Depot in this park.

### **Nicholson Wildlife Refuge**

This 127.4 acre park is the hidden gem of the park system. It is located on 5 Mile Road between Nicholson Road and County Trunk V (9500 – 5 Mile Road). This park has the Louise Erickson Trail which leads you back into the wetlands for viewing.

### **Woodland Park**

This 3.9 acre park is located behind the East Side Community Center at 6156 Douglas Avenue. It has the Leffler Nature Trail with benches, picnic tables, and a brick patio.

### **Maple Park**

This 5 acre park is located off of Johnson Avenue in the new Maple Park Subdivision. This neighborhood park benefits the area with open space and a playground.



### **Opportunities for Projects**

### **Rules and Regulations for Shelter Rentals**

- ✓ Hours of use are from sunrise to sunset.
- ✓ Clean-up and set-up is the responsibility of the renter. All trash must be placed in receptacles and the grounds and restrooms clean when the picnic is over. The renter will be held responsible for any damages and/or clean-up that is required after the event.
- ✓ Decorations are permitted but must be removed by the renter at the conclusion of the event. A charge will be assessed to the renter who made the reservation if Village staff has to remove decorations.
- ✓ Any materials or equipment belonging to the renter must be removed from the facility and grounds at the conclusion of the activity.
- ✓ The use of entertainment (DJ's, amplified sound, inflatable bouncers, animals, dunk tanks, clowns, etc.), the use of motorized equipment and/or generators and use of tents or similar structures, must be approved by the Village of Caledonia Park Commission before the picnic. If permission is granted, a letter will be issued to the renter.
- ✓ Reservation permits and any special permission letters must be available at the picnic. These permits must be available should Caledonia Police / Sheriff have a question.
- ✓ Open fires are not permitted in any park. All fires/cooking must be done in a grill.
- ✓ Individuals or groups renting park facilities will be held responsible for the conduct of the people admitted to their activity. Parking is limited to posted areas. Please do not park on the grass at any time.
- ✓ If an emergency occurs, contact the Caledonia Police Department by calling 835-4423 (non-emergency) or for an emergency call 911.
- ✓ A rental can be terminated immediately at the discretion of the department or the Caledonia Police for any violation of rules/regulations, any department policy, or any other Village or County ordinance violation.
- ✓ Glass is not permitted in any of Caledonia's parks.
- ✓ For the park and shelter ordinances, go to Title 12 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances.



**Field usage by the General Public**

- ✓ Baseball and softball fields are used by Caledonia Youth Baseball from April through July. If you wish to reserve a field, you may call the Village Hall.
- ✓ If available, sports fields are reserved by filling out a reservation form at the Village of Caledonia office.

- ✚ Fees include Beer & Wine Permit.
- ✚ Keys are required to open the restroom at Crawford Park. Renters may pick them up at the Village Hall before the function. If these keys are not returned to the Village Hall after the function, the renter will be assessed an additional charge for key replacement.
- ✚ To reserve a shelter, payment must be paid in full.
- ✚ Renters may cancel a reservation 10 days prior to the function and receive a full refund.
- ✚ Cancellations are not accepted within 10 days of the function and no money is refunded.
- ✚ If the Village has to cancel the reservation, the renter will be issued a full refund or be offered another date in the future. (i.e. due to flooding, plumbing problems, etc.)
- ✚ Renters reserve the shelter only and do not have exclusive rights to the playground equipment, or other areas of the park.
