WHAT TO RECYCLE

HOW TO PREPARE

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

-ALL Cardboard

- corrugated cardboard
- container board
 - cereal boxes
 - soda or beer containers
 - laundry soapboxes



- Fold or cut to form pieces no larger than 3' x 3' and lay pieces together
 - Tie in bundles 10" thick or less
- OR**
- Place in a brown paper bag
 - Place bag/bundle on top or next to recycle bin
 - Placed neatly into another box no bigger than 3' x 3'

NEWSPAPERS

- Newsprint** including inserts
- Magazines, phone books & catalogs**
- Junkmail & envelopes**
- Office paper** (Any color)
- No Packaging Material**
 - Foam Polystyrene (Popcorn, Styrofoam, etc.)
- No tissue, paper toweling or paper contaminated** with food residue or other debris, frozen food boxes or dairy carton boxes



- Tie in bundles 8" thick or less
- OR**
- Place in brown paper bag
 - Place bag or bundle on top of recycling bin

GLASS CONTAINERS

- Jars & Bottles Only**
 - No** light bulbs
 - No** dishes
 - No** window glass or auto glass
 - No** broken glass



- Any Color (clear, green, brown, etc.)
- Lightly rinse
- No need to remove labels
- Remove lid & place in regular refuse

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

- Containers marked #1-7 (PETE or HDPE, etc.)**
 - soda, liquor bottles, milk, detergent, water, shampoo, juice, gasoline, etc.
 - No** radiator or anti-freeze bottles
 - No** motor oil bottles



- Lightly rinse
- Do not place plastic bags in recycling bin
- No need to remove labels
- Suggest that containers be crushed
- Remove lid & place in regular refuse

STEEL OR TIN CANS

- Food cans only**
 - No** cans for paints or chemicals



- Lightly rinse
- No need to remove labels
- Suggest that containers be crushed
- Remove lid and place in regular refuse

ALUMINUM CANS

- Cans only**
 - No** foil, pie plates or caps
 - No** car parts, nails, screws, medical supplies, pots & pans, gasoline cans & scrap metal



- Lightly rinse
- Suggest that containers be crushed
